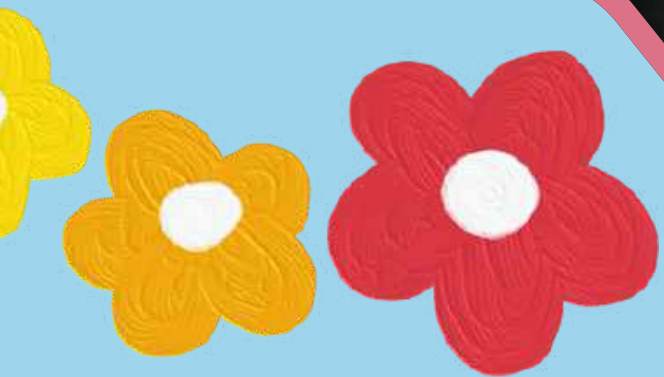

Your Fees

If you would like your child to attend all year round you will be charged for 51 weeks. This includes bank holidays & nursery closures which are chargeable.

Your bill will be annualised so you will receive the same bill each month. If a child starts, leaves or changes sessions part way through a month, the charging will revert to monthly charging for that specific month and then return to annualised billing for the coming months.

If you access hours above your funding entitlement your bill will be annualised meaning it will be the same each month.

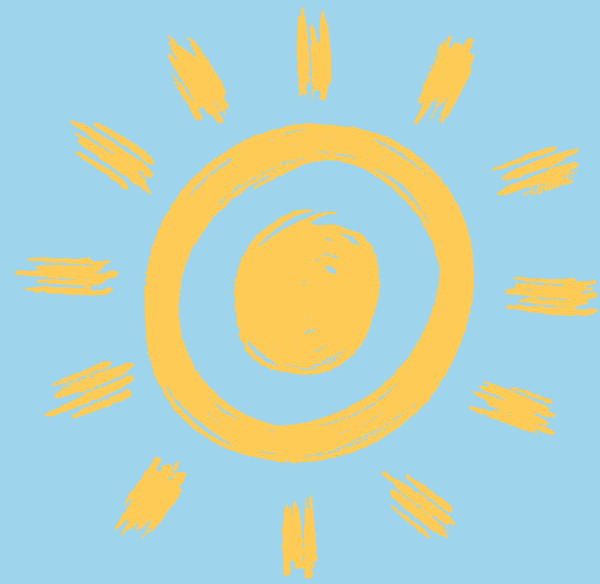
Weekly fees x 51 weeks / 12 months = annualised monthly amount.

Non-attendance for holidays, birthdays etc will still be chargeable. We allow 2 weeks at half fees per year. This is deducted and reflected in your annualised monthly bill.

Payments are due on 1st of each month for the upcoming month.



Working parent funding



30 hours per week

For children aged 9 months and older, you're eligible for up to 30 hours of funded childcare per week. Over 38 weeks, this would total $30 \times 38 = 1140$ hours.

Parents receive a consistent bill reflecting the funding being stretched evenly over the year, which is 22 hours per week. Children who start within the summer term (April-August) may incur a reduced amount of hours based on the reduced amount of available funded sessions.

Application Process

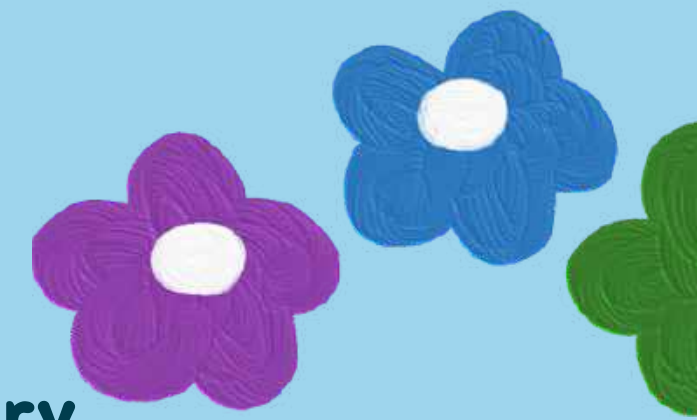
To apply, head to the government website to set up a childcare account. If you pay for childcare and want help with costs through tax-free childcare, you can apply using the same service. Please complete the funding application online.

You will need your National Insurance number, Unique Taxpayer Reference (UTR) if self employed and other relevant details.

Remember, eligibility criteria may vary, so it's best to check the official government website for the most up to date information.



Universal Funding



15 hours of funded childcare is available for every family in England with 3 and 4 year old children.

You will receive 15 hours of funded childcare per eligible child per week during term time (38 weeks per year), totalling 570 hours per year. Parents receive a consistent bill reflecting the funding being stretched evenly over the year, which is 11 hours per week. As it is available to everyone, there is no need to apply and this will automatically applied as long as parent agreement has been completed.

Term Time Only Places

If you require a term time only place, please enquire with the nursery as early as possible to ensure we have availability as we only have a limited number of term time only spaces.

If you wish to use your funded hours with no additional charges, this can be accommodated. Please contact the nursery to discuss further.

Your child will be entitled to universal funding the term after they turn 3:

Born 1st Jan- 31st Mar - Eligible from April Term

Born 1st Apr- 31st Aug - Eligible from September Term

Born 1st Sept- 31st Dec - Eligible from January Term



Government supported funding



If you live in England and receive certain benefits, your 2-year-old may be eligible for funded childcare. Details can be found on Best Start in Life website.

What's covered?

Eligible children can receive funded childcare for up to 15 hours per week during term time (38 week of the year). This totals $15 \times 38 = 570$ hours maximum per year.

Additional Help

EYPP Funding

The Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) is available to early years providers who offer government-funded early education places. This funding is aimed at improving the education of disadvantaged children aged 9 months and above.

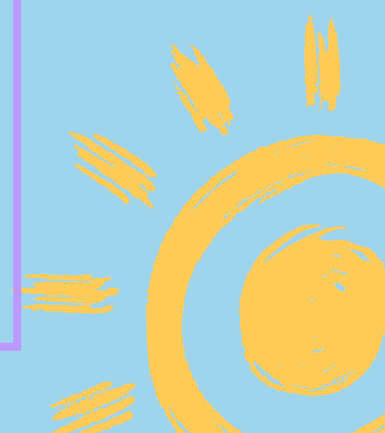
DAF Funding

Disability Access funding is available to support children with special educational needs and disabilities who are in receipt of disability living allowance. They become eligible for DAF when they start receiving government funded early education.

Funding Example

Essentials & Extras

Government funding is intended to deliver up to 30 hours a week of free high quality childcare.

Government funding is not intended to cover the costs of providing nutritious meals & snacks, other consumables such as creams, apples, wipes etc, additional hours or educational outings and extra curricular enrichment activities.

At Heirs & Graces we believe that providing a child with a nurturing and engaging environment shapes a child's future. We do this through providing the highest quality care and education through a range of activities and experiences, including extra curricular activities such as French classes, sports sessions, sign language classes etc. We therefore charge for these within our consumables cost to ensure we sustainably offer these enriching experiences.

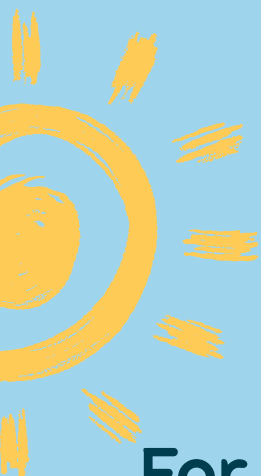
The consumables payment and meals payment are optional and should you wish to opt out of paying these additional fees, there are alternative options available to you. Alternatives can be discussed with the nursery manager.

The charges are as follows and only apply to the sections of your booking where funding is applied.

Consumables (including nappies, wipes, extra curricular activities etc) - £6 per full day £3 per half day

Meals (including breakfast, 2x snacks, lunch & tea) - £8 per full day, £4 per half day





Tax Free Childcare

For every £8 you pay into an online tax free childcare account, the government will add an extra £2, up to £2000 per child per year. Essentially this scheme results in a substantial 20% saving on your childcare costs. Your tax free childcare account can be used to pay us for your childcare directly. You will need to reference your child's unique reference code so we can allocate the payment to your account.

You may be eligible for tax free childcare if you are:

*working and each earning at least National Minimum Wage or Living Wage for at least 16 hours per week

*Earning under £100,000 each per year.
